Important information please read carefully prior to assembly!

Each ceiling bracket is subject to quality control and testing before it is dispatched. Please unwrap the components carefully! The polished or nickel-plated metal surfaces of the product are sensitive. Do wear gloves and mount the parts on soft pads like blankets etc. The glass is sensitive to hits and may be damaged or scratched when handling is not gentle. Leave the bubble foil on the glasses as long as possible to prevent damages during the mounting procedure.



This is a low-voltage LED light! Always use the included power supply and never connect the light cable directly to the 220 V mains network. This would destroy the light completely.

Important! Electrical devices may only be installed and assembled by qualified electricians. Applicable health and safety regulations must be observed. Shut off the mains supply (switch off the automatic circuit breaker) before commencing work on the device in order to prevent electric shocks. Failure to adhere to the installation instructions may cause fires or other hazards.


Important! Do not twist the wire-insulated light cable!


Mounting


The DB e80 ceiling bracket consists of a holder, a cable clamp and a customized ceiling rosette / cover with 80 mm x 80 mm and 31 mm height. Unscrew the connection between these components.


- 1. Cut the wire-insulated cable to length and prepare the cable ends for the terminal block.
- 2. Mount the holder to the ceiling using screws and wall plugs supplied (Picture A).
- 3. Pass cable of light through the ceiling rose and then through angle. Please note direction the cable has to be passed through the angle (Picture B). Adjust cable to appropriate length by locking the cable in the required position using the cable clamp supplied. Attention! Do not screw too tight! The screws may damage the electrical cables inside.

 Connect the cables via terminal block.
- 4. Push the ceiling rose over the holder (Picture C).
- 5. Fix ceiling rose to holder using screws supplied (Picture D).









Care

The ceiling rose is varnished, nickel-plated or made of polished aluminum, and therefore is susceptible to scratches and improper treatment. Polished metal surfaces will gradually oxidise/anodise and develop a patina.

For cleaning we recommend the use of a moist cloth and standard glass care products.
