### LAROSE GUYON COCO

As a tribute to the legendary fashion designer Coco Chanel, Montreal-based Larose Guyon's handmade Coco lamp mimics a string of pearls with 10 hand-blown glass and brass globes that can be arranged in several configurations. A counterweight and hook can be added or moved from one 'pearl' to another, bringing an elegant touch to this luminous piece of art.



### NOVUS ATTENZIA

A 2018 Red Dot Design Award winner, the Novus Attenzia luminaire series brings the dynamics of natural daylight into work areas. It alters brightness and colour temperature throughout the day with its lighting system, developing the optimum lighting performance for office spaces. The three light panels, rotatable to 270°, offer enhanced flexibility and optimal glare protection. The adjustable joints enable easy positioning of illumination.

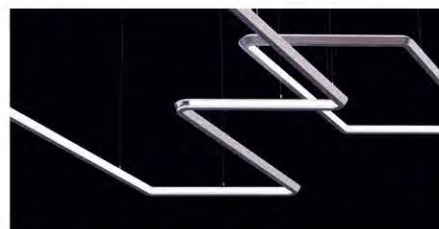
### MASSIFCENTRAL CASINO

German brand Massifcentral produces bespoke homogeneous, glare-free and dimmable project lighting using solid mineral glass with a natural gas process that creates an advanced diffuser technology. Resembling sparkling water or champagne bubbles, the glass bodies are turned into a functional diffuser for a range of ceiling, wall and table lights, not to mention the distinctive Grand Cru (below) and Casino chandeliers.



### SELUX FLUID

Developed by Berlin-based design agency e27, Fluid is a hovering modular pendant frame that generates concentrated brightness within the room without an apparent central source – perfect for an office or retail setting. The asymmetrical aluminium units, featuring a trapezoidal cross section for a linear LED module, can be configured in a near-limitless range of shapes by combining different angular sections.



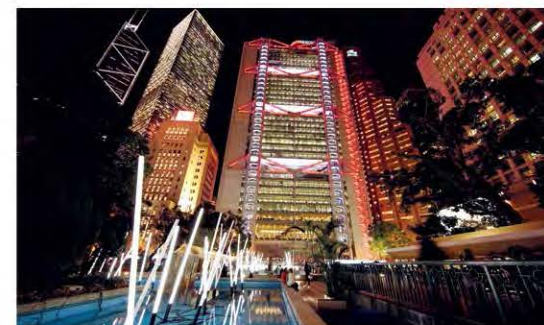
### VOLATILES

Berlin-based Volatiles combines the magic of light with beautiful clusters of glass mosaic tiles. Its mobile app-controllable and Wi-Fi-connected light modules are able to display a huge range of colours. Each tile is sensitive to touch and can be individually illuminated with its special click-fitting mechanism to create a personal symphony. The energy-efficient and space-saving wall of light can be installed in any interior settings such as halls, spas, ceilings and bathrooms.

### LIGHTING UP HONG KONG

After making its debut in 2017, *Lumieres Hong Kong* will return for its second edition this November. Now running for four days, Hong Kong's very own light festival will see close to 20 heritage landmarks in the city lit by various light projections and installations created by international and local artists who've been inspired by local history and culture. *Fête des Lumières*, the largest and best-known light festival in the world, will continue to support *Lumieres Hong Kong* as a partner. The general public will be able to see the city's beauty under a new light and join an eventful programme of activities such as workshops, guided tours and performances.
